Aim and Objectives

- 1. The Barnet Homes Resident Support Group, provides Barnet Homes residents with the opportunity to be actively involved and take part in helping Barnet Homes improve its housing services, through a range of involvement and consultation activities
- 2. Residents will receive invitations to take part in although not limited to;
 - Attending housing related Focus Groups to provide feedback on the services they receive
 - Take part in mystery shopping exercises
 - Take part in telephone surveys
 - Receive training to appoint new contractors
 - Attending housing related meetings
 - Providing feedback on our strategies and policies
- 3. The Barnet Homes Resident Board works alongside the Resident Support Group, seeking resident feedback on Barnet Homes services and areas where Group identify areas where there is room for improvement if housing services
- 4. Members of the Resident Support Group will receive regular email communication from The Barnet Groups Community Engagement Team, inviting them to take part in its involvement opportunities
- 5. As recognition for their involvement, in some cases residents will be incentivised with high street shopping vouchers to the value of between £20 to £30. Further details of this *is set out within the groups Customer Expenses and Incentives Policy*
